New and Returning Student Orientation will be held at RRCA 1330 Jackie Road on:

New students and parents are required to attend one of these sessions.

You will be provided with essential information to participate as a partner in your student's education during the orientation. During the year, if there are changes to your personal, work or emergency information please update that information with the registrar.

RRCA students are expected to set goals and keep up with their work. All students enter RRCA on a three week probationary status.
