

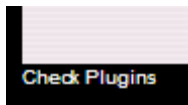

## Overview of E2020

The Education 2020 Virtual Classroom is a multimedia classroom with interactive activities. In some ways the Virtual Classroom is like a traditional classroom. You will go to your homeroom for announcements and to communicate with your teachers and advisor. The lessons include lectures, online content, homework practice and tests. The Virtual Classroom is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through the Internet. You have the ability to review and revise lessons. This guide instructs you how to log in and navigate the Virtual Classroom.

## A. Start E2020

1. Go to <http://student.education2020.com>
2. Turn off **Pop-Up Blockers**
3. First time click on the **Check Plug-ins**
4. If a plug-in is needed click on the hyperlink, these are required and free applications.

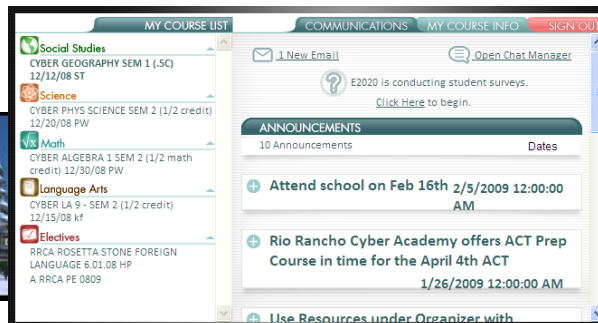

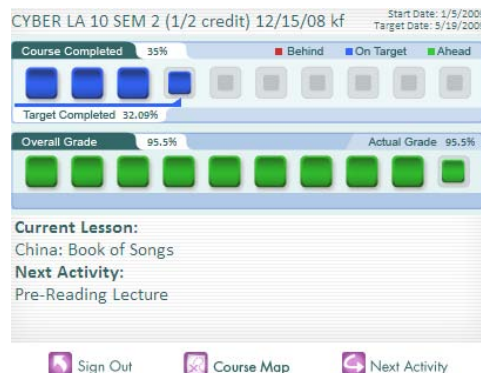


## B. Select Your Course

1. My Lobby is the first screen you will see
2. **My Course List** on left shows all your classes
3. **Announcements** on your right – **read them daily!**
4. Top tabs access other features



5. Click on course name on left to have the progress show up of that particular course along with accessing the class through **Course Map** or **Next Activity**.



## C. Course Activity Details

Each lesson has a standard set of steps you must follow. These steps are the activities you must complete, sequentially (in order presented) to advance your progress bar.

- *When complete with a step Click on exit.*  
**If the Exit button is RED ←EXIT then you are not done with the step.**  
**A green EXIT button ←EXIT informs you that the step is complete.**
- Use eNotes in all steps of the E2020 program to document the lesson's objectives, point out important facts, and record what is being learned. eNotes are turned on to use for all quizzes, topic tests, and final exams.



If the Exit button is RED ←EXIT then you are not done with the step.

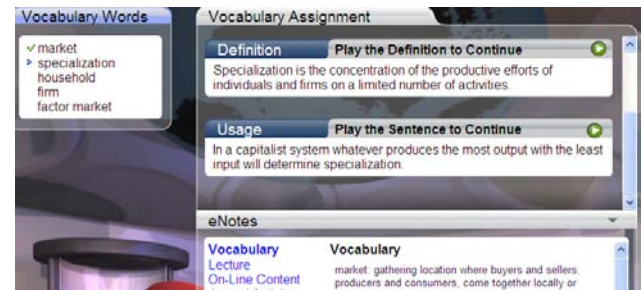
A green EXIT button ←EXIT informs you that the step is complete.

## 2. Step Two – Lecture.

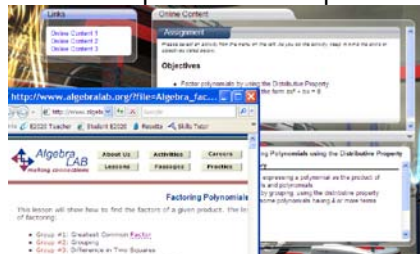
The lecture is a video that provides the *majority of all the material needed to learn, grow and master* the objectives from the lesson. Realize that the fast-forward button with the DVD controls will only work after the video has been watched entirely.

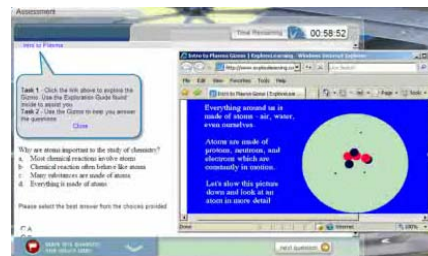
## 4. Step Four – Journal Activity.

## 5. Step Five – Lab Lecture and Lab Assessment

- Only found in Math and Science
- Lecture explains the Lab
- Lab is the Gizmo
- Use **EXPLORATION GUIDE** to help work your way through the Gizmo
- Gizmo activity used to answer Lab Assessment questions

## 6. Step Six – Essays

Found only in Language Arts



- Read the directions!!!!
- Know what you are writing about
- Click
- Click [YES, this information is CORRECT. I would like to CONTINUE.](#)
- Write/type – follow the writing program

## 7. Step Seven – Practice Homework.

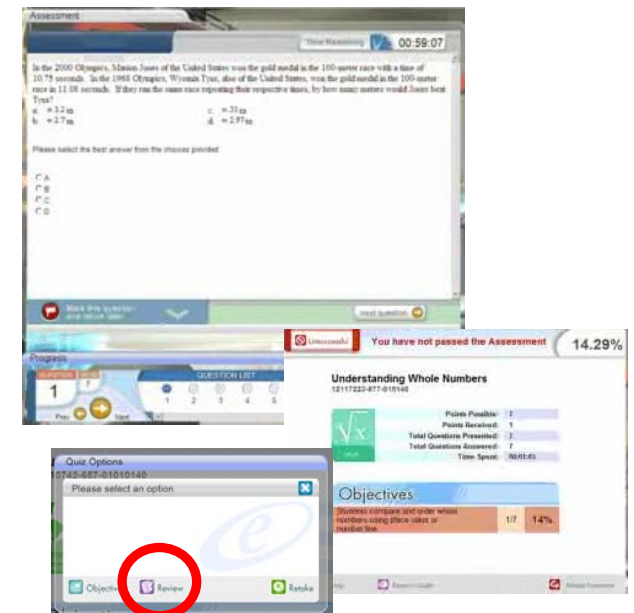
- Homework/Practice activities are meant to help you review before an assessment
- Homework/Practice activities will have various styles of questions (multiple choice, short answer, etc...)
- After submitting your answers the program will show you the correct answers compared to your answers

## 8. Step Eight – Quiz/Tests.

- Pass the quiz with a minimum grade
- Number of attempts to pass quiz are limited
- Retakes are only given upon approval of Advisor and/or Content Area Teacher
- Quizzes at the end of the lesson (7-10 Questions)
- Topic Tests at the end of unit (25 Questions)
- Cumulative Exam at end of semester (50 Questions) **These Finals must be taken in lab!**
- Select answers by clicking the chosen response
- Move to the next question with the buttons or arrows at the bottom of the question window
- Use the eNotes (*better notes student takes throughout the lesson then the better notes they have to refer to during the assessments*)
- Use the Course Map to review lesson material before taking the assessment
