Dear Parents:

I am sure most of you know that there have been some minor changes in our current school calendar. The board has approved to give all staff an extended Spring Break. With this change, our school will be closed from March 19th through March 29th for Spring Break. Classes will resume on March 30th. With the schools being closed early, we had to adjust our parent conference schedules. Teachers will be available for parent/teacher conferences the week of March 9th thru March 18th. Conferences will be held daily before and after school. Every attempt will be made to schedule conferences at a convenient time for you.
