

Priority populations for seasonal flu

- Seasonal
 - Pregnant women
 - Caregivers of children <6 months old
 - Caregivers of anyone at risk of influenza complications
 - >50 years old
 - Living in nursing homes or longterm care facility
- Any age with certain chronic medical conditions

Priority Populations for H1N1

- First Priorities as established by CDC
 - Emergency and Health care workers*
 - People 6 mo.-24 yrs.*
 - Pregnant women*
 - Those who care for children <6 mo. old*
 - Adults with conditions making them at risk
- Initial Vaccine Shipment Priorities
 - Health care & emergency medical personnel with direct patient contact
 - Children 6 mo – 59 mo of age
 - Pregnant women
 - Children ages 5- 18 with conditions that put them at risk

NOTE: Due to small numbers and only live attenuated vaccine in the very first shipment of H1N1 vaccines, we will be vaccinating only healthy 2-4 year olds in our offices. More vaccine is expected soon.
