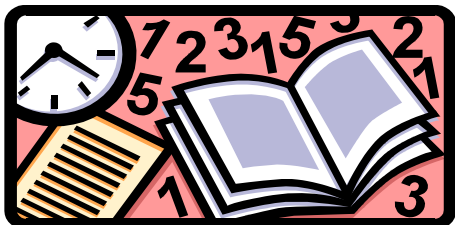


DEAR MATH STUDENT:

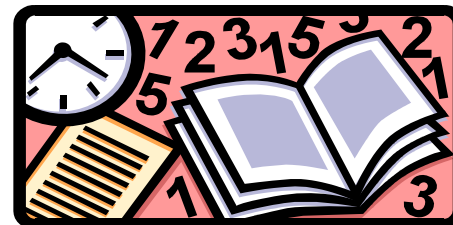
