APPLICATION FOR BENEFITS UNDER TITLE VII**

There are limited funds available under Federal Title VII to provide tuition-free enrollment in the 2008 Summer Session for Native American students. These funds will be dispersed on a "first-come, first-served" basis.

In order to verify the student's eligibility, a Federal Form 1810-0021 (formerly Form 506) must be on file with Rio Rancho Public Schools. This form requires the Native American tribal registration or identification number under which the student is eligible. A copy of the form is provided on the reverse of this page.

If you have already completed the form and filed it with Rio Rancho Public Schools, you may indicate the applicable tribal registration number below in order to expedite the enrollment process.

If you have **not** completed and filed the appropriate form, it must accompany the student's Application for Enrollment for the summer session. **It is not necessary to complete a Scholarship Application under this program.**

You will be notified if the Title VII funds have been depleted and the enrollment can not be processed.
