Your child had a wonderful, yet short time investigating the theme "Harvest". You child had a great time learning about pumpkins, how they grow, and the different sizes pumpkins can be. You child enjoyed painting a picture of a pumpkin, some were little, and some were big. It is great to see your child approach each new theme and letter with excitement and interest in what we are learning.

It was terrific to visit with you during your child's parent/teacher conference. Your child has made many gains during the first part of preschool. It was great to celebrate all of the accomplishments your wonderful preschool star has made.

### **Here is a Special Note for this week:**

- **We will have an assembly on Friday. The performing group Bayo Seco will be here to perform for the school. They are a musical performing group. They will perform once for the AM classes and once for the PM classes.**

We will begin our investigation of Humpty Dumpty this week. This theme is connected to the letter "H." Our ZooPhonics animal for the letter "H" is Honey Horse. The theme Humpty Dumpty, will allow the children to remember some of the activities we did for the letter "E" as Humpty Dumpty is an egg. Some of the activities for the week are as follows:

- Creating a wall with a box and foam squares for Humpty Dumpty.
- Creating a model of Humpty Dumpty to use on the wall.
- Sequencing the story of Humpty Dumpty with picture cards.
- Creating Humpty Dumpty puzzles that can be put back together.

We will also work on the concepts of 'hard' and 'soft' this week. We will work to be scientists and figure out what surfaces will keep Humpty Dumpty safe if he fell on them and what surfaces may not keep Humpty Dumpty safe if he fell on them.
